To All Customers

As harvest approaches we would like to take a moment to address the issues facing us this fall. At the forefront is the Coronavirus. As I am sure you can understand, we must take precautions to insure the safety and wellbeing of our customers and staff.

Limit Exposure at our facility. As we receive grain this fall, we will limit the contact between drivers and staff, both office and receiving. We ask that all drivers stay in their trucks when dumping grain. We ask that drivers do not enter the office beyond 3 feet inside the front door. We will have a Plexiglas divider to protect both customers and office staff when you receive your ticket. We will continue to have snacks and refreshments, but we will bring those to you upon request. There will be a portable toilet outside for drivers that need to use the restroom. When possible, try to coordinate with office and receiving staff VIA phone to try and limit personal contact. At all times, when drivers are outside of their vehicle, masks will be required. Masks are available on sight if necessary. When a customer will need to come into the office to review settlements, please call in advance and wear a mask when you come in.

On a brighter note, we will have our new website up and running soon. It is www.sidellag.com. This will have our current cash bids and hours of operation on the homepage. More content will be added at a later date. Beginning early next year, we will be implementing daily texting for any customers who are interested in receiving cash bids via cell or email.
